A parenting programme called Strengthening Families Strengthening Communities (SFSC) for families with housing issues. Six 13 week courses per year providing practical parenting skills and peer group support. Where possible these are run in collaboration with the services described below.

COMMUNITY RESOLVE:

Mediation and peer mentoring for families where there is a serious breakdown in family communication or where there is a risk that the young person may become homeless. Two mediators – one older and one younger – work together to help restore communication between family members and support them in managing their conflicts. 10 families per year.

Key worker provides intensive support for up to 7 – 8 vulnerable homeless families per year with multiple and complex problems.
